### **Summer 2017 Camp Theme – SO LOVED!**

Our Summer Camp 2017 theme is SO LOVED! This summer at Eagle Sky we will be focusing on God's incredible love for each and every one of us. Each day we will dive into a different aspect of His love. We will explore His love for us all, His love for us individually, and His love for others through us.

At Eagle Sky we believe it is our calling to share the fullness of the Gospel with every camper that comes through the gate. When Jesus tells us in Matthew 28:19 to "go and make disciples of all nations" we intend to do just that! At Eagle Sky, we put emphasis on teaching kids and youth how to be fully devoted disciples of Jesus Christ and how to receive everything that Jesus paid for when He died for us on the cross. We strive to teach kids and youth that because of Jesus we can live blessed and victorious lives.

### **Daily Sub-themes**

Each day at Eagle Sky we have a sub-theme for the day that ties into the overall summer theme. Our goal is that each day we impart one biblical truth to campers that they can understand and apply to their lives.

**Day 1: Welcome to Camp/Rules/Theme Introduction**

**Day 2: We are... SO LOVED! (Love for Mankind/Savior)**

*For God SO LOVED the world that He gave His only Son – John 3:16*

On this day we will start with the basics. God loved us SO much that He literally sent His only son, Jesus, to be beaten and die for us on a cross because we needed a Savior. And only by sending His son could the world be saved. All we have to do is confess Jesus as our personal Lord and Savior we can experience a personal relationship with Him and live eternity in heaven.

**Day 3: I am...SO LOVED (Promises/Needs)**

*For all the promises of God in Him (Jesus) are YES! - 2 Corinthians 1:20*

On this day we will dive into God's love for us individually as His children. We will explore the many promises of God that are ours because of what Jesus did for us. We will discuss what it means to be one of God's children and how to live a blessed and victorious life.

Jesus told us one of the greatest commandments was to love our neighbors and God has given us the Holy Spirit to help us love others the way God loves us. Being full of the love of God makes loving others easy, because it's God loving through us!
